#### Day 1 – Arrive in Delhi

Arrive at Delhi International Airport where the Ethical Wildlife team greets and assists with your hotel transfer.

Evening orientation dinner and overnight stay in Delhi.




# Day 2 – Fly to Jabalpur $\rightarrow$ Drive to Kanha

Begin your journey with a morning flight to Jabalpur (included), followed by a scenic four-hour drive to Kanha National Park. Upon arrival, check in at the Lodge, a tranquil retreat surrounded by dense forest. As evening descends, gather for an introduction to the region's rich natural history and a detailed photography briefing to prepare for







# Days 6 - 7 - Tracking Tigers in Bandhavgarh

Enjoy morning and afternoon safaris in Bandhavgarh's famed core zones

— Tala and Magdhi — known for their remarkable tiger density. Capture
striking images of tigers framed by ancient temple ruins, dense forests,
and golden-hour meadows. As the day winds down, return to the Lodge
for dinner and an overnight stay amid the tranquility of the forest.



#### Day 8 - To Panna via Khajuraho

Depart in the morning for a scenic five-hour drive to Panna Tiger Reserve, stopping en route at the magnificent Khajuraho Temples — a UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its intricate carvings and architectural brilliance. Arrive by evening at the Lodge, where dinner and an overnight stay await amid the serene wilderness.




#### Day 9 - Safari in Panna

Spend the day exploring Panna's dramatic ravines and the scenic Ken River valley on morning and afternoon safaris. Keep your lens ready for leopards, sloth bears, vultures, and gharials as you traverse this diverse landscape. In the evening, unwind at leisure or opt to visit a local conservation project for a deeper insight into the region's wildlife efforts.



#### Day 10 - Train to Agra

After a final morning safari and breakfast, depart Panna and board a train to Agra. Upon arrival, check in at the Hotel. Spend the evening at leisure or join an optional guided heritage walk to explore the timeless beauty of Agra's historic streets.



#### Day 11 - Agra to Delhi Departure

Witness the magnificent Taj Mahal at sunrise, followed by a delightful breakfast. Later, drive back to Delhi for your evening departure and airport drop-off. An overnight stay in Delhi can also be arranged upon request at an additional cost.




